March Meeting Updates...

Mar 4: Dan Dutcher, NCAA Chief of Staff, Division III told us the organization began as the result of injuries incurred by the Flying Wedge football formation. It is controlled by the member colleges; has 125 committees and 1000 representatives. ESPN and CBS contracts provide 85% of the budget.

Mar 11: Sgt. Terry Bauer, Indiana State Excise Police explained the job of this agency as having a focus on alcohol, tobacco, gambling and control of drug use. Just 10 officers have to cover 16 counties. A new area they now oversee is identity theft.

Mar 18: Bob Rouch & Bob Artis of Deming Park Holly Arboretum announced the one in TH won several awards and was named the best urban forestry project in Indiana in 1999. It has 8 species and over 300 plants. Holly is native to all continents but Antarctica. Info available at deminghollyarb@yahoo.com

Mar 25: Judge Paulette Stagg, Vigo Cty Juvenile Court explained the type of cases she sees. In 2002 she had over 240 cases related to methamphetamine busts.
