Board of Director's Monthly Meeting Update

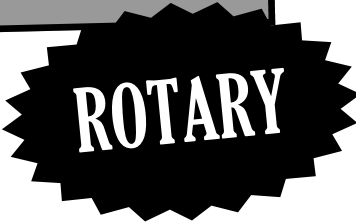
- Attendance for November was 87.6% with YTD at 69.8%.
