January Meeting Updates

January 8: Dr. David Prentice, Indiana State University. Stem Cell Research. He shared with us information about stem cell research. Embryonic research has not yielded the positive results that have been seen using adult stem cells. Much debate still exists. Jerry Einstandig reported the slate of officers for the next term. All was approved by the membership with official duties beginning July 2002.

January 15: John Lustig, curator of the Permanent Art Collection at ISU. He has transformed Chicago cows into Terre Haute Sycamore leaves for the 2002 Crossroads Art Fest. Individuals and business can purchase a "leaf" and decorate it.

January 22: House Speaker, John Gregg talked

with us about the disappearance of the budget surplus. It was used for Excise tax reduction, Old Age and Homestead exemptions on property tax, to add dollars in to the Teacher's Retirement Fund and the Police and Fire Pension fund. Current possibilities for increasing \$\$\$, include taxing gambling, raising sales tax, and increasing State income taxes and cigarette taxes.

January 29: John Perry. Union Federal Bank. John shared his insight into the economy. Our country has been a mild recession since March 2001 when a reduction in business spending occurred.
