- The monthly attendance for June was 64%, and year to date was 69.8%. Club membership is 175 persons.

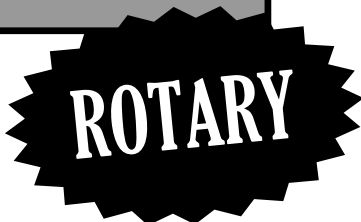
