## Board of Director's Monthly Meeting Update

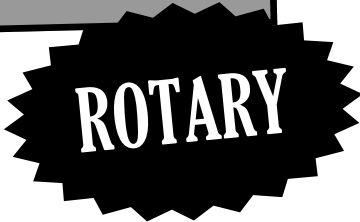
- Attendance for February was 73.2% with YTD at 52.4%.
