- June 18 we will have a picnic as our regular club meeting at Deming Park from 1200-100. Watch for more information.

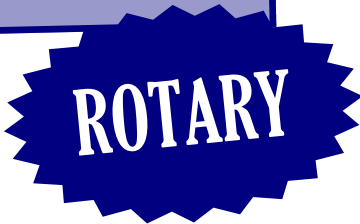
