October Meeting Updates

October 2:

Foster Propst, Director of Pharmacy, Terre Haute Regional Hospital, shared the medication checking process and the internal education going on within THRH related to Patient Safety. He advised all of us to become a more knowledgeable consumer regarding our own and our family's healthcare.

October 9: Archie Kappel and Steve Witt, Aisin Brake & Chasis Plant. Aisin looked at 70-100 sites before selecting Terre Haute. Aisin is the 4th largest automotive components maker in the WORLD. They will be in the Industrial Park on 50 acres. Initially they will hire 35 then 180-200 new jobs by 2004.

October 16:

District Governor, Ron Brogan. Mr. Brogan dis-

cussed Rotary International President Rick King's challenge to each club to improve it's membership. District Governor Ron presented Past President Bill Aubin with a banner noting our Club was 3rd in the district for contributions to the Rotary Foundation.

October 23: Mike Leopard, Exec Director, Indiana Utilities Regulatory Commission. He spoke about its oversight of the utilities in Indiana. Mike addressed issues pending in the commission and its legislative issues related to out of state merger and ability to fine utilities for noncompliance.

October 30: Alan Ley, Union Hospital. He presented us with a three part program designed to encourage us to get fit and control stress. Steps include 1. Have a plan 2. Build a foundation 3. Find a way to make it fit in your life.
