- Doug DeShong has resigned from the club and thus stepped down from the Sergeant-at-Arms position.

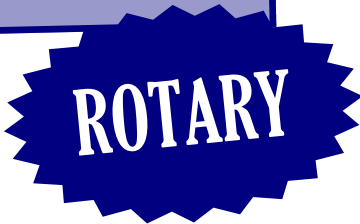
